

## **Martha Wilson**

Martha Wilson, Founding Director of Franklin Furnace Archive, will speak about her early career in Halifax and the development of Franklin Furnace at a lecture on March 18, 7 p.m. at the Port Campus. Her presentation, entitled Staging the Self, is part of the NSCAD Public Lecture Series.

Franklin Furnace Archive, established in 1976, is a museum in lower Manhattan that presents and preserves temporary installations, performance art, along with temporal art, artists' books and multiples produced internationally after 1960.

Ms. Wilson lectures widely on the book as an art form, on performance art and on "variable media art." Between 2003 and 2006, she served as guest editor of Leonardo magazine's feature sections on live art and science on the Internet. Ms. Wilson has also developed exhibitions, publications, courses and pedagogical resources concerning post-modernism.
